



How to set up your Mail™ on an iPhone 3G or 3Gs



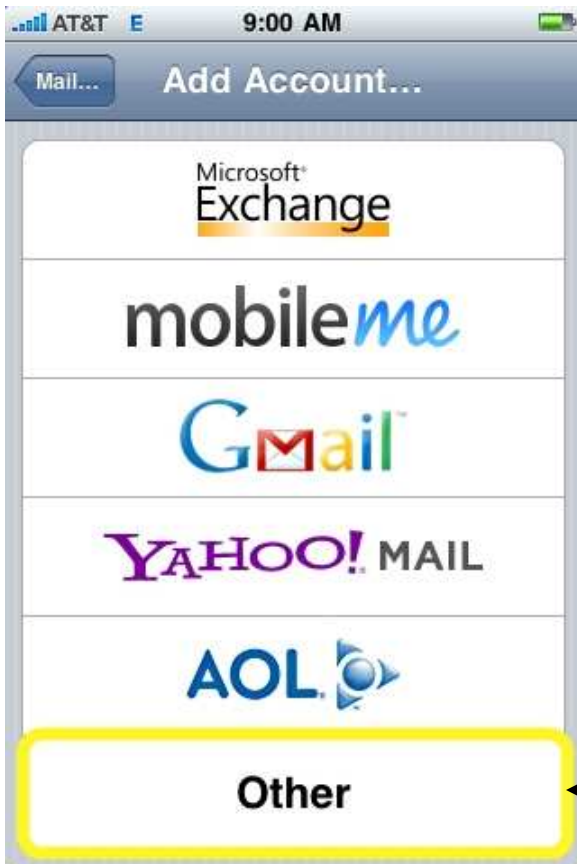
← Click on the **Settings** button from the home screen



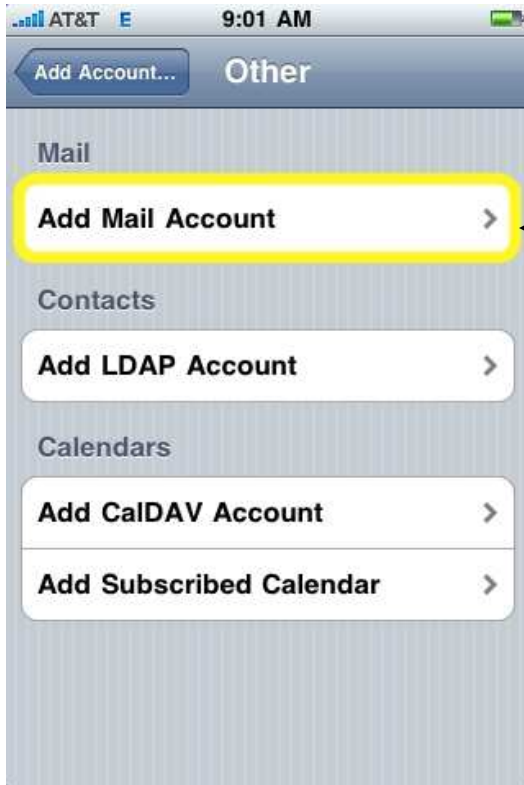
← Click on the **Mail, Contacts, Calendars** from the settings screen



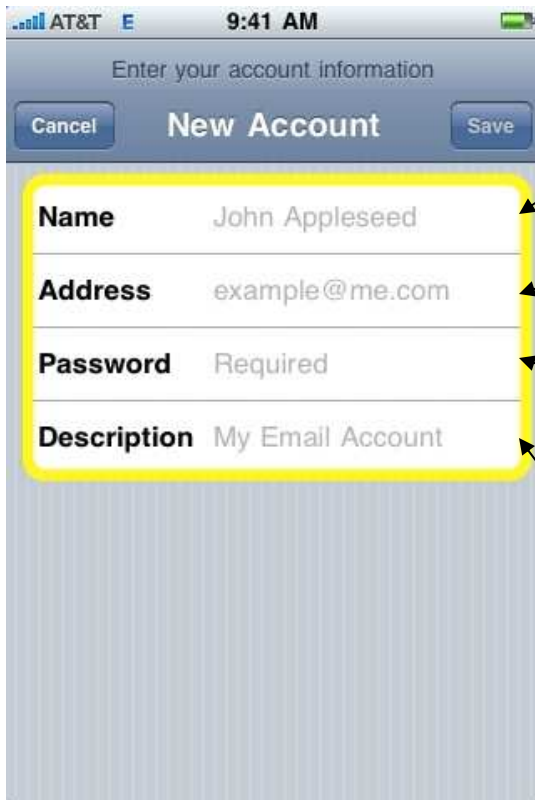
Click on **Add Account**



Click on **Other**



Click on **Add Mail Account**



Enter the Display **Name**.
This can be whatever you would like, typically your first and last name

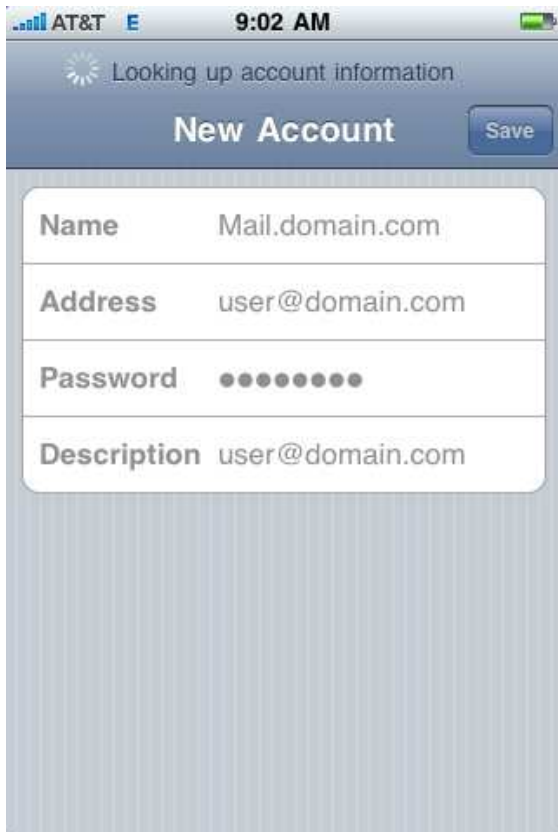
Enter your **E-mail address**
This is the one you are setting up

Enter your mail **Password**.
This is the password that you set up when you configured your mailbox in your Network Solutions Account Manager

Enter a **Description**
This is used to distinguish this account from any other email accounts that you might be using on your iPhone



Click on **Save**



It may take a minute or two for your iPhone to attempt to look up any information

Click on **POP**

These should already be filled in from the last step. There is no need to change them if they are correct.

Click on the **Host Name** field and enter: **mail.domain.com**
 Be sure to use your domain name, not domain.com

Click on the **User Name** field and enter your **FULL e-mail address**

Click on the **Password** field and enter the **Password**
 This is the password that you entered when you set up your e-mail account in Network Solutions Account Manager

Click on the **Host Name** field and enter: **smtp.domain.com**
 Be sure to use your domain name, not domain.com

Click on the **User Name** field and Enter your **FULL e-mail address**

Click on the **Password** field and enter the **Password**
 This is the password that you entered when you set up your e-mail account in Network Solutions Account Manager



When you are done entering your settings click on **Save**



Your iPhone will now attempt to connect to the server and verify that it can connect. This will verify that all the settings were entered correctly.

This may take several minutes.



Click on **Yes** when this box pops up on your screen.

This will come up twice. Click **Yes** both times.



The account you just set up will show here.

Note: a screen will pop up for 1 second that shows that the account has been verified and then you will immediately be taken to this screen.

You are finished!

You can hit the home button on your iPhone to return to the home screen to access your e-mail.
